

## Minutes of Committee Meeting

- Apologies for absence: AY,JM
- Previous minutes from meeting on 21.10.20 were circulated beforehand and all present were happy that the minutes were a true and accurate record.
- Membership report:
  - o 183 members in total.

  - Proposed and agreed to move new membership in line with EA rules. ie. new members joining after January 1<sup>st</sup> have membership through to April the following year. No more half price memberships after Mob Match.

  - Adopted the new criteria for adding virtual race miles to the STAR totals. Criteria attached below.

  - Agreed that no further communication outside of STARC about the kit change was needed at this stage.

Criteria for mileage to count towards STARC club stars.

To count either:

The run should be UKA licenced, or by another approved body.

The run appears on Power of 10 or runbritain.

It is a registered parkrun.

It is part of the Cornish GP, MTRS, DAN series.

For virtual runs to count:

They too should be licenced events (by the UKA or other body)

They should be part of a recognised 'event' and the event should take the same format as the original event and be done in one session. e.g. a marathon should take place as one session, as did the 2020 London Marathon, and not over a number of days or sessions.

Results should also be verified on an external website to prove ratification by the organising body.

If a virtual event is submitted for consideration, the above criteria will be considered but it would not be guaranteed to count towards the 'star' total.
